

Scheme Name	Greenhouse Management and Shade Net Management Training Program
Objective of scheme	To create self-employment and employment opportunities by providing greenhouse management and shade net house management training to members of the target group.
Nature of the initiative	Organizing free residential greenhouse management training for members of the target group.
Training venue	Eligible target group member will be provided 5 days of training at National Institute of Post-Harvest Technology (NIPHT), Talegaon Dabhade.
Eligibility criteria	The target group members must apply on website sarthi-maharashtragov.in for availing benefit of the scheme. Applications made by candidates are reviewed and scrutinized by Sarthi's Divisional Office after filling the online application form. All documents are checked online as per terms and conditions of the scheme. Recommendations will be done online if all documents are correct. If there is queries in the application, application will be sent back. Queries received online have to be compiled online. Failure to fulfill the condition will result in disqualification. a) The applicant should be a Maratha, Kunbi, Maratha-Kunbi and Kunbi-Maratha from Maharashtra. b) The annual income of the family should not exceed Rs. 8.00 lakhs. c) Applicant must not have previously benefited from this scheme implemented through Sarthi, Pune. d) The applicant's age should be minimum 18 and maximum 50 years. e) The candidate should be a resident of Maharashtra.
Required documents:	While applying online, the applicant is required to upload the following documents in PDF format. All uploaded documents should be clear and readable a) Caste certificate (for Kunbi-Maratha, Kunbi-Maratha and Maratha Kunbi) b) School leaving certificate or caste certificate (for Marathas)

	c) Non-Creamy Layer Certificate / EWS Certificate / Income Certificate of the Tehsildar stating that his annual income for the last three years does not exceed Rs. 8.00 lakhs. d) Aadhar card, guarantee letter and 2 passport size color photos e) Birth certificate or school leaving certificate f) Domicile Certificate and 7/12 extract
Beneficiary Selection Process:	a. Advertisement for filling online application for benefit will be published on the Sarthi website and in newspapers in the state. b. Eligible applicant will be selected on first come, first basis c. Information will be given to beneficiary about the training date and selection according to the capacity of the training class. d. A maximum of one member of a family will be selected for training. e. The said training will be free.
Nature of benefit:	As per the MoU signed with National Institute of Post-Harvest Technology (NIPHT), Talegaon Dabhade, Pune, a residential fee of Rs. 7500/- per trainee will be paid to the training institute for five days residential training. This training fee will include one breakfast, two teas and two lunches and field visit. The training fee will be paid to the training institute after successful completion of the training and after receipt of training fee from the training institute. The students do not need to pay any fee and this training is free for them.
Ineligibility Criteria:	a) Documents being incomplete and not being submitted within the prescribed time limit. b) Filling in false, incorrect or incomplete information while filling out the online application. c) violation of terms and conditions of scheme The final authority to determine the selection process and the nature of financial assistance will remain with the Hon'ble Managing Director, Sarthi, Pune.
